To amend the Oil Pollution Act of 1990 to improve that Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. AUDITS AND REPORTS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Title I of the Oil Pollution Act
- 5 of 1990 (33 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) is amended by adding
- 6 at the end the following:
- 7 "SEC. 1021. AUDITS AND REPORTS.
- 8 "(a) Audits.—Not later than April 30 of the fiscal
- 9 year in which this section is enacted, and every 2 years
- 10 thereafter, the President shall provide to the Committee

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on Environment and Public Works of the Senate and the 2 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the 3 House of Representatives an audit conducted by the 4 Comptroller General of the United States that includes a detailed accounting of all funds from the Fund in excess 5 of \$100,000 that are— 6 7 "(1) disbursed by the National Pollution Funds 8 Center; and 9 "(2) administered and managed by the receiv-10 ing agencies, including final payments made through 11 agencies, contractors, and subcontractors. 12 "(b) Reports.—Not later than February 28 of the 13 fiscal year in which this section is enacted, and every February 28 thereafter, the Secretary, the Secretary of the 14 15 Interior, the Secretary of Transportation, the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency, and the 16 heads of any other Federal agencies that, during the pre-17 18 ceding fiscal year, received funds from the Fund in excess 19 of \$100,000, shall— "(1) provide to the President a report account-20 21 ing for the uses of the funds by the Federal agency, 22 including a description of ways in which those uses 23 relate to— "(A) oil pollution liability, compensation, 24

prevention, preparedness, and removal;
