Holloway, Jr. U.S. Courthouse at 200 Northwest Fourth Street, Oklahoma City, OK, and the U.S. Post Office and Courthouse at 215 Dean A. McGee Avenue, Oklahoma, City, including the Federal Parking Garage, at an additional estimated construction cost of \$4,277,000, an additional management and inspection cost of \$257,000, for a total additional project cost of \$4,534,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution, is approved. This prospectus amends Prospectus numbers POK-0046/0072-OK22.
