
For the congressionally directed spending item, the name and location of the intended recipient or, if there is no specifically intended recipient, the intended location of the activity:

The purpose of the congressionally directed spending item:

Senator Kohl requested a technical correction to the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: a Legacy for Users regarding item number 5132 – striking the project description and inserting “St. Croix River crossing project, Wisconsin State Highway 64, St. Croix County, Wisconsin, to Minnesota State Highway 36, Washington County.” The Wisconsin Department of Transportation requested the change because the original language included instructions to “reconstruct and rebuild” the St. Croix River crossing, when in fact a new bridge was being constructed.
