

## **ROADS AND BRIDGES**

- **\$3 billion** over five years through highway formula funding
- **\$506 million** over five years specifically for bridge infrastructure
- **\$195 million** for Corridor H and ADHS projects
- Eligible to compete for \$2 billion in new competitive rural infrastructure grant program, including **\$500 million specifically for ADHS.**

## **WATER AND WASTEWATER**

- **\$142 million** over five years for clean drinking water infrastructure
- **\$223 million** over five years for wastewater infrastructure
- Funding dedicated to **lead pipe remediation** and per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (**PFAS**) **cleanup**

## **BROADBAND**

- **At least \$100 million** for broadband deployment in addition to formula-based funding for West Virginia
- West Virginia's **unserved and underserved areas would be first and second in line**, respectively, to then receive formula-based funding, through the U.S. Department of Commerce

## **AIRPORTS**

- Invests **\$40 million** in primary airports in West Virginia, including Charleston, Huntington, Lewisburg, and Clarksburg
- Invests **\$20 million** to airports participating in the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Contract Tower Program, which includes Wheeling Ohio County, Morgantown, Parkersburg/Wood County, and Greenbrier Valley

## **OTHER**

- Reauthorizes the **Abandoned Mine Land** (AML) program
- Cleans up orphaned oil and gas wells
- Boosts **carbon capture** infrastructure
- **Permitting** reform
- \$1 billion for **Appalachian Regional Commission**
