Consistent with the requirements of paragraph 9 of Rule XLIV of the Standing Rules of the Senate, I certify that neither I nor my immediate family has a pecuniary interest in the new Environmental Infrastructure authorization I have requested for Hawai'i in the Water Resources Development Act of 2022.

There is neither a specifically intended beneficiary for this request, nor a specifically targeted location. Rather, the authorization is intended to allow the Corps to respond flexibly to assist communities across the state on water-related environmental infrastructure and resource protection and development projects, including projects for—

- (1) wastewater treatment and related facilities;
- (2) water supply, urban storm water conveyance, treatment, and related facilities;

- (4) environmental restoration; and
