

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

Section 3066 authorizes funding to continue the aquatic ecosystem restoration on Koontz Lake being carried out under section 206 under WRDA of 1996.

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
For the congressionally directed spending item, the name and location of the intended recipient or, if there is no specifically intended recipient, the intended location of the activity:

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

Section 1009 (02) authorizes funding to conduct a study and carry out a project to prevent and mitigate damage cause by navigation projects.

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

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Cedar Lake, Indiana

Degraded water quality of Cedar Lake, has significantly decreased the aquatic ecosystems and associated socioeconomic benefits of the lake. The project will determine and implement an alternative for reducing the amount of nutrients and sedimentation into the water column from the sediments within the lake. Dredging, erosion control, and boating restrictions are some of the potential options.

Authorizing Language

CEDAR LAKE, INDIANA.

a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary is authorized to plan, design, and construct an aquatic ecosystem restoration project, Cedar Lake, Indiana, substantially in accordance with the feasibility report referred to in subsection (b).

(b) **COMPLETE FEASIBILITY REPORT.**—In carrying out the project authorized by subsection (a), the Secretary shall complete expeditiously the feasibility report initiated pursuant to section 206 of the Water Resources Development Act 1996 (33 U.S.C. 2330) for the Cedar Lake, Indiana, aquatic ecosystem restoration project and to proceed to design and construction of the project immediately.

(c) **AUTHORIZATION.**—The Secretary is authorized to use funds previously appropriated for undertaking an ecosystem restoration project at Cedar Lake, Indiana, under the authority provided under section 206 of such Act to carry out the project authorized by this section.

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
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Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission (ORSANCO)
