

**COMMITTEE RESOLUTION**  
**LEASE**  
**FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION**  
**GREATER METROPOLITAN CLEVELAND, OHIO AREA**  
**POH-01-CL22**

*Whereas*, pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307(a), no appropriation to lease any space at an average annual rental in excess of \$1,500,000 for use for public purposes may be made without the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate and the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives approving the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

*Whereas*, on November 22, 2022, the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate (the Committee) adopted a resolution under 40 U.S.C. §3307(a) approving a proposed lease prospectus by the General Services Administration (GSA), identified as POH-01-CL22, for the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) currently located at 1501 Lakeside Ave. East and 1100 East 26<sup>th</sup> Street in Cleveland, Ohio, at a proposed annual cost of \$7,617,560 for a lease term of up to 20 years;

*Whereas*, as of November 22, 2023, no appropriations had been made for this proposed lease, and no appropriation has been made since; now be it
