**EDWARD A. GARMATZ UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURTHOUSE
BALTIMORE, MD
PROJECT SURVEY**

**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF
THE UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 3316 (b), the Administrator of the General Services shall investigate the feasibility of constructing a new facility in Baltimore City to replace the Edward A. Garmatz United States District Courthouse to provide for the long-term space, safety, and security needs of the courts to be housed in such facility, to achieve substantial energy efficiency and environmental performance improvements over the existing courthouse facility, and to support the economic conditions of the neighborhoods surrounding the new facility; and shall submit a report to Congress within 90 days.
