Title of Request: Eastern Shore and Southwest Virginia Authorization Modification

Name of Requesting Senator: Mark R. Warner (D-VA)

Intended Project Location: Lee County, Virginia

Purpose of the Congressionally Directed Spending Item:

The 1999 Water Resource Development Act (WRDA) included an authorization for “Eastern Shore and Southwest Virginia” with a Federal limit of \$20 million for the ten Virginia counties in the regions. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Nashville District office is currently using this authority for an ongoing wastewater infrastructure project in Lee County, Virginia. The current authorization level is insufficient to carry out the project in its entirety, necessitating an increase in the authorization limit to **\$32 million** to fully scope and complete both the design and construction of the project.
