Dear Chairman Barrasso and Ranking Member Carper:

I am writing on behalf of **Dynatemp International, Inc.** to urge your support for the swift consideration and passage of *The American Innovation and Manufacturing Act of 2019* (AIM Act) (S.2754).

Dynatemp International, Inc. ("Dynatemp") is a medium size business that supplies the air conditioning and refrigeration industry with fluorocarbon-based refrigerants (hydrochlorofluorocarbons-HCFCs and hydrofluorocarbons-HFCs) that are integral to the cooling that air conditioning and refrigeration equipment provide homes, autos, transportation, manufacturers and institutions. As a responsible environmental steward, Dynatemp actively sources recovered refrigerant so that it can either be reclaimed (brought back to original specification) or incinerated instead of being vented into the atmosphere where it may have a detrimental impact on our atmosphere and global temperatures. Dynatemp is a privately held company that was founded in 1983. We have locations in Arizona, North Carolina and Pennsylvania serving a wholesale customer base of 550+ companies representing over 4,100 HVAC/R wholesale locations nationwide. Of this total number, there are over 250 locations that are our customers. Dynatemp has 14 full-time employees and 45 sales agents nationwide, all based in the United States.

The AIM Act provides a federal framework for phasing down hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) and enabling an orderly transition to next generation refrigerant technologies. This is vital to the continued competitiveness of the U.S. heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration (HVACR) sector.

According to a study by the Interindustry Forecasting group at the University of Maryland, the phase down of HFCs will:

- Create 33,000 new U.S. manufacturing jobs and sustain 138,400 existing jobs between now and 2027;



- Increase direct U.S. manufacturing output by \$12.5 billion, and total (direct and indirect) U.S. manufacturing output by \$38.8 billion between now and 2027; and,
- Improve the U.S. trade balance in equipment and chemicals by \$12.5 billion.

These trade and economic benefits are why the AIM Act is broadly supported by a large, bipartisan group of more than 30 Republicans and Democrats in the United States Senate and has the support of the U.S. HVACR industry, the National Association of Manufacturers, and the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.

I respectfully request your help in securing a prosperous future manufacturing and innovation in the United States with the enactment of the AIM Act as soon as possible this year.

As a national supplier of refrigerants and refrigerant recovery and abatement services, contributing our voice to issues which directly affect our business is paramount and we deeply appreciate the ability to submit this written testimony.
