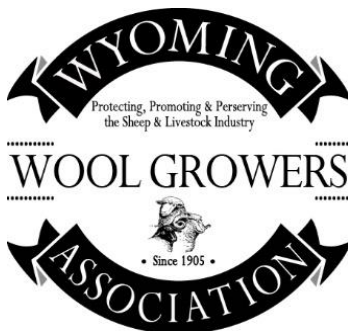

On behalf of the Wyoming Wool Growers Association, we appreciate the opportunity to review the draft of H. R. 8 "America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018" that you are proposing in the nature of a substitute. We have not reviewed the entire bill but instead have paid close attention to the portions of the bill that are important to the state of Wyoming, such as Sec. 3301 of Subtitle D which relates to Fontenelle Dam, and Title V - EPA-Related Provisions.

Based on our review of these parts of the bill we are pleased to offer you our support for the language. We are especially pleased to see the language regarding Fontenelle Dam, which is long overdue. In addition, Title V contains a number of important provisions that are beneficial to Wyoming and our communities.

The Wyoming Wool Growers Association supports the proposed language in this bill and again wish to thank you for your continued efforts to craft legislation that provides practical solutions and answers to Wyoming's needs.
